Students at your school will participate in a local and global day of community service; their sister school will present at a student summit in Uganda at the same time your students are participating in acts of community service!

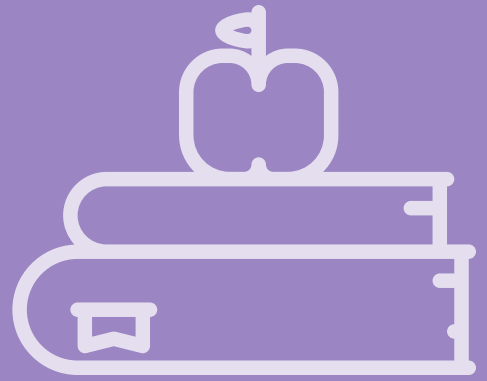


Education

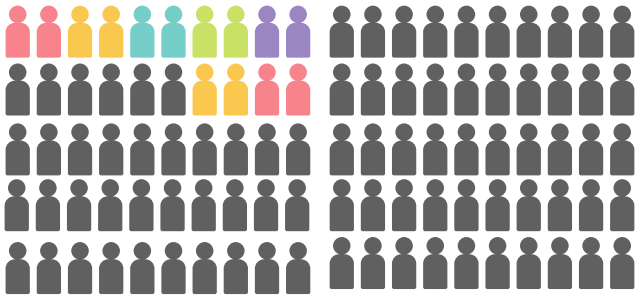
UGANDA'S YOUTH ARE IT'S LARGEST DEMOGRAPHIC:

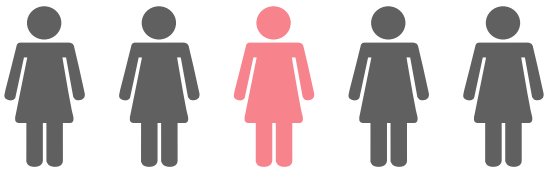

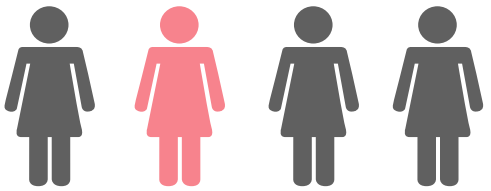
IN RURAL COMMUNITIES IN NORTHERN UGANDA ONLY
